

## SL Meeting Minutes

June 30, 2018

- Katie started by going over social media takeovers for the week.
  - Everyone had signed up previous to Convention, but any gaps were filled in.
  - Instructions were given about what kind of content to post.
  - SLs were reminded which events they needed to cover on social media based on what day they had signed up to take over for.
- DeAndra mentioned that an idea had come up for SLs to take short videos of attendees to find out what they were in school for or what they wanted to do with an English degree.
  - This idea came largely out of a discussion with Dave to promote diversity among English majors in career choice and trajectory.
  - It was also suggested that these videos could be used to create a kind of promotions video for NCTE members if they were strung together into a larger compilation.
  - Any students taking over Snapchat were asked to try to capture some of these kinds of videos of Convention attendees throughout the week.
- Katie also briefly talked about the Convention app and ensured that all SLs were aware of the app, how to access it, and how to use it.
- Everyone was reminded about what events they were required to attend throughout the week.
  - This led to a discussion of the SL events being held.
    - Each region gave an update on their plan for the SL Workshop being held Thursday morning.
    - Every region was responsible for having an activity planned based on one of the stages of the writing process.
    - Everyone reported that they had any necessary materials and were prepared for the workshop.
  - DeAndra then gave an update on the SL Game Night for Friday.
    - Everyone was asked if they brought games to contribute to get an idea of what we would have at the event.
    - DeAndra said that all of the materials we needed to make the Monopoly board were not at the hotel yet, so a time was set to work on the board later in the week.
    - We also discussed what time SLs should be at both of these events for set up and the responsibilities of the SLs at game night – mainly to facilitate and ensure attendees knew what was happening.
    - Elfie also gave an update on the prizes available for people to win.
- Elfie then went over the merchandise photo shoot happening on Wednesday.
  - SLs were told where they were needed and when, and details of the shoot were covered.
- Katie and DeAndra then went over the schedule again, making sure that everyone knew where they were needed to be and when.
