

**English Education Ad-hoc Committee Minutes**  
**Board Meeting**  
***Feb. 26, 2014, Savannah, GA***

1. Designate English Education Strand components and assign a committee person to handle each component for the 2015 Convention
2. The Committee needs to know which schools have EN/ED programs; we'd like a question added to the Chapter Report so that we can more easily identify these schools; we'd also like Regents, perhaps on Regional Facebook pages, to ask which schools have English Education programs, whether one program or an English program with some sort of Certification
3. We'd like to create a "sub" webpage for English Education under Sigma Tau Delta (like the one for alumni)
4. What English Education component strands would we want for the 2015 convention?
  - Student teaching
  - Teaching the common reader
  - Technology
  - Starting an NEHS chapter (as part of a lagniappe session with interview and resume preparation components)
5. Should this committee continue to exist as a separate entity or be subsumed into a Membership Constituency Committee? While there is some concern about who would set up the focus for the Membership Constituency Committee and how to ensure that English Education stays a priority, there's a general sense of support for a single committee rather than continuing as an ad-hoc committee. We anticipate this committee (English Education Ad-hoc) will exist at least through the Fall 2014 Board meeting and we will plan accordingly.
