The consensus seems to be that the opportunities are outweighing the negatives...so far!

3. Application question

After hearing the language of the first question, the Committee leans toward keeping the Convention theme as part of the language, even in the future.

- 4. Removing limitations on chapter submissions
 - a. Need to follow up with Sponsors

We need to have an email blast (maybe even an announcement that comes with the second round of Convention essay blogs) that lets Sponsors know about this change and reminds about the nominating statement no longer being needed. Glen Brewster notes that the Sponsor Luncheon would be an ideal place for an announcement.

- 5. Increased opportunities
 - a. Current scholarships/awards
 - b. Future offerings
 - i. Diversity
 - ii. Travel grants

We are following the urging of the Strategic Planning, which suggested we focus on the scholarships we have and improve those, rather than offering other options.

Propose looking at the scholarships that attract very few submissions in the fall...
